# LUKE 7: 1-17 COMPELLING FAITH

### social status

Notice the role of hierarchy and power in the story. Pay attention to Jesus' response to the different characters: a Roman Centurion, a servant, and a Jewish woman.

### about the text

the culmination

> "I tell you, not eve in Israel have I found **such faith**."

> > -Jesus

### emotional tone

"**fear** seized the all" (vs 16)

Consider your own **emotions** and **thoughts** as you read.

### Read the story aloud together.

# activity + discussion

Divide into two groups.

One group will discuss the story from the perspective of her widow and her dead son.

The other group will discuss the story from the perspective of the group following Jesus after he healed the centurion's servant.



## What you were feeling, thinking, and experiencing before Jesus offers healing?

### What you were feeling, thinking, and experiencing after Jesus resurrects the dead man in the funeral procession?

### **Closing Reflection Questions**

Do you believe that God looks at your life and feels compassion for you?

Why or why not?

What else does God feel?

All of us will experience (or have experienced) a moment of hopelessness, when it feels like all is lost.

Thinking about what you have studied and discussed today, and consider how you might ask God to work in your life and in the lives of those you love in the moments.
